REGISTRATION NIGHT. You do not need to go to this if you intend to register online.

No EFT-POS facility, so please bring cash or cheque. A ‘used boot and gear sale’ being held at the Registration night and Fun Day. Offering good used gear at lower cost than buying new. Bring along any boots or other gear to either of these events, and donate them to the club. Will then be selling this gear at \$5-\$10. All money will go to the club. CLEAN boots please. “New” gear also available (see below under “Gear”).

NURSERY GRADE: commences - Saturday 17th April, David Farrington Park, 9.00 to 10.00am continuing every Saturday through till end of August. Bring boots, a drink bottle, with shinpads compulsory.

GEAR: Shirts only: - supplied by Club. Socks: - black, with two blue hoops or plain black. Shorts: - plain black, can be purchased from Champs Sports, level 1, 230A Left Bank, 116 Cuba Street. All junior soccer gear will also be able to be purchased at the clubrooms on Registration night, 11th Feb, from representatives of Champs Sports.

CANCELLATIONS: Listen to Newstalk ZB Radio on 1035 AM frequency. Broadcast half hourly from after the 7.00am news. Listen for the “category” your child plays in. Likely “Categories” are: *Junior Premier League & Promotion League, Junior Combined League* (include Wgtn teams 10th to 14th grade). *Wellington Junior Football* (Wgtn 7th to 9th Grades), *Mana Junior Football & Hutt Valley Junior Football*. No mention of your category, means no cancellation.

TRIALS: Players in 9th Grade teams and above will be streamed and trials held to fall into line with NZF policy. Trials are generally held in March with dates, times and venues determined by the Grade Manager and the JPL & Promo team coaches. This information will be available on the club website under JUNIOR. With up to 500 registrations to process the final placement of children into teams etc. does take time. You will not be forgotten!

COACHING COURSES FOR COACHES: Capital Football are planning to run further courses for new and developing coaches this year. The club is very keen to support coaches improving knowledge and skills. The club will fully fund Small Whites Introduction to Coaching course (note there are free small whites coaching courses being run for any females who want to do introductory course in wgtn Monday 15/2 from 6 till 8pm at Seatoun AFC and Wednesday 17/2 from 6 till 8pm at Karori AFC). For other Junior courses the club will pay half the course costs, with the individual paying the other half. All club payments subject to budgetary restraints.
